

# St Bernards Road Pedestrian Actuated Crossing Upgrade

## Works Notice

A series of safety upgrades for pedestrians and cyclists is now underway throughout South Australia under the nationwide Road Safety Program.

The recently announced \$168 million investment will deliver critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional and urban roads. Footpaths and cycle paths will also be improved. The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) Governments over two years (2023-2025).

## What's happening:

We are planning to upgrade the current pedestrian crossing on St Bernards Road, Hectorville to improve safety.

Site investigations and survey works are required to help us better understand the existing road conditions. This work will also help inform our design and construction planning.

## How this affects you:

To do this work safely, there will be changes to traffic conditions. Please follow onsite signage and traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access for safety; however, traffic controllers will be on site to show you where to go. There may be some noise from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.

Access for public transport will be maintained, however, please check the latest updates on scheduled services at [adelaidemetro.com.au](https://adelaidemetro.com.au)

Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.
