

Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

Works notice

We are improving safety and supporting regional economic growth

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler to improve safety and traffic efficiency for all road users.

What's happening

We are undertaking minor finishing works on the Sturt Highway overtaking lanes, between Blanchetown and Waikerie. Once complete these works will improve safety and amenity for all road users.

How this affects you

Sturt Highway will remain open at all times.

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works, there will be changes to traffic conditions. During working hours Sturt Highway will have speed and lane restrictions in place throughout the work area.

Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place for the duration of the project. Please plan your trips, observe onsite signage and the follow direction of traffic controllers.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained. If temporary access restrictions are required, advanced notice will be provided.
