

Road Safety Program - Grand Junction Road and Fosters Road Crosswalk Upgrade

Early works

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional and urban roads, footpaths and cycling paths around South Australia as part of the Road Safety Program. This \$168 million program is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments over three years.

What's happening

To help inform the final design of an upgrade to the existing crosswalk at Grand Junction Road and Fosters Road, Oakden we are undertaking survey work.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place on Grand Junction Road and Fosters Road during working hours.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through the area. Some areas may have restricted access, with traffic controllers and on-site signage to guide you to alternative routes.

Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.
