

# City Tram Extension Project

Important Information for Residents / Business Proprietors

Dear Resident / Business Proprietor

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of night works along King William Road, between North Terrace and the Adelaide Bridge on King William Road over the River Torrens.

Night works are scheduled to commence from **Monday 30 January** and be completed by **Thursday 2 February 2017**, weather permitting. The works will occur between the hours of 7pm to 5am.

The works will involve pavement and geotechnical investigations to provide information for the detailed design of the City Tram Extension Project.

These works are being undertaken at night in order to minimise the impact to road users and to complete the work safely and efficiently.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. A 25 km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby businesses and residents. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are undertaken.
