

# Adelaide Hills Intersection Upgrade Planning Study

## Onkaparinga Valley Road, Tiers Road and Nairne Road intersection, Woodside

Dear Resident/Property Owner/Business Owner

The Australian Government has committed \$2 million within its Roads of Strategic Importance Initiative to upgrade the Onkaparinga Valley Road, Tiers Road and Nairne Road intersection in Woodside.

The intersection forms a staggered-T arrangement and is located within a 50km/h speed zone in the Woodside township. Onkaparinga Valley Road carries around 10,500 vehicles per day to the north of the intersection and around 8,500 vehicles per day to the south of the intersection. Nairne Road carries approximately 4,000 vehicles per day.

The upgrade will seek to improve intersection safety and operation, balancing local community and industry requirements, and cater for future regional growth.

A Planning Study for the proposed intersection upgrade is underway and community and stakeholder engagement forms an important part of the study. As planning progresses consultation with landowners, businesses and residents will occur to help inform the preferred concept and design.
