



Station Refresh Program Works

Nurlutta Railway Station

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering improvement works at 14 stations along the Gawler rail line. The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$20 million as part of the Gawler Rail Line Station Refresh Program.

Works at Nurlutta Railway Station include:

- installation of new station shelters;
- installation of new seats and bins;
- new line marking;
- new LED platform lighting; and
- new station name signage.

Works will be carried out intermittently at the station from **Monday, 29 November 2021, until early 2022**, weather permitting. Hours of work are 7am to 5pm Monday to Saturday. Please note that there will be no works between Friday, 24 December 2021 and Monday, 3 January 2022, inclusive.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Some temporary pedestrian detours will be in place intermittently around the work site and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.
