## Industry Forum and Local Government/Agency Forum

As advised in the last SCAP update report before the Commission on 14 October 2021, the SCAP initiated a feedback forum in mid-November 2021 to gain feedback from people within the industry who regularly interface with the SCAP, as well as provide an opportunity for SCAP to offer advice on what is useful to SCAP deliberations and the interpretations of proposals.

SCAP hosted the Industry Forum (two sessions) on Wednesday 17 November 2021, and the Local Government/Agency Forum on Friday 19 November 2021.

Overall, the forums were very well received by attendees. All sessions contained constructive discussions about the SCAP and its procedures.
