Pedestrian Crossing Activation Christie Downs Railway Station - Update

Works to upgrade the pedestrian crossing at Christie Downs Railway Station, between Justin Crescent and Finbar Crescent, Christie Downs are continuing.

To finalise signalling, commissioning and activation of the pedestrian crossing, **works will be continuous** over the long weekend from 5pm Friday, 30 September to 5am Tuesday, 4 October, weather permitting. On completion of the works the pedestrian crossing will be opened as an active crossing.

An active crossing means when a train is coming, the pedestrian gates will automatically close. Alarms and signals will let pedestrians know it is unsafe to cross. When the train or trains have passed and it is safe to cross again, the alarms and signals will stop and the gates will re-open. The pedestrian crossing will be closed from **6am Saturday**, **1 October to 6pm Monday**, **3 October 2022**. Signage will be in place to detour pedestrians via Flaxmill Road.

During night works, temporary lighting towers will be installed around the pedestrian crossing to ensure safe working conditions for the team.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works during the day or early evening where possible.

The works have been scheduled to coincide with the planned closure of the Seaford and Flinders rail lines over the October long weekend, due to works occurring at the Brighton Road, Hove level crossing.

Substitute buses will operate between Adelaide Railway Station and Seaford/Flinders railway stations from first service Saturday, 1 October to last service Monday, 3 October 2022. Trains will resume normal running from first service on Tuesday, 4 October 2022.
