Site investigation activities

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$85 million (50:50) in funding towards an upgrade of the intersection of Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive.

Upcoming site investigation activities.

Service locating works are continuing at various locations through and around the intersection at Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive.

To ensure the works can be undertaken safely and efficiently the investigations will be undertaken at night from Sunday, 26 February for approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting. Hours of work will be between 7.30pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday, weather permitting. No works will be undertaken on Saturday night.

These works involve service locating equipment being used to detect any underground services and potholing works.

The intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
