Yamba Rest Area Upgrade

Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler as part of the Roads of Strategic Importance program.

As part of this program, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport is improving safety and access to the westbound rest area at the junction of Bede Road and Sturt Highway, Yamba.

What to expect

Works are scheduled to commence on Monday, 17 April 2023 and expected to be completed in mid-2023, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday. Some weekend work may be required.

Works will involve:

- the construction of a deceleration left turn lane into the rest area;
- widening of the rest area exit; and
- reconfiguration of the rest area exit to improve safety for motorists exiting the rest area onto the Sturt Highway.

To safely facilitate these works speed and lane restrictions will be in place during works. Outside of working hours speed restrictions will be in place, subject to on site conditions. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.

During construction, local access to properties on Bede Road will be maintained as well as continued access for emergency services.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible.

We appreciate your cooperation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
