

Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Main Road, Cherry Gardens

As part of the State Government's election commitments, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is planning safety upgrade works on Main Road, Cherry Gardens. This project forms part of the \$150 million Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package which includes a range of road improvements to support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience in the Adelaide Hills.

As part of the project, further site investigations and vegetation assessments are required along **Main Road**, between **Black Road** and **Chandlers Hill Road**. These investigations will help further develop an understanding of the site conditions and will inform the next stage of planning for the project.

The investigations have been rescheduled and will be undertaken on **Friday, 14 April 2023**. The works will be undertaken between **9am** and **3pm**, weather permitting.

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Local access to properties will be maintained throughout the work area, with advance notice provided to residents if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

The Department appreciates your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
