Level Crossing Studies

The Australian and South Australian Governments have also committed to a Level Crossing Removal Planning Program to conduct planning studies at priority level crossing locations.

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport has identified the level crossings at Cormack Road in Wingfield, Kings Road in Parafield and Park Terrace in Salisbury as priority locations for planning studies.

Level crossings can lead to safety problems and travel time unpredictability as trains, cars, buses, trucks, cyclists and pedestrians' cross paths.

The planning studies will seek to better understand the problems at each location and identify potential opportunities to remove the level crossings, improve safety and make travel easier for all users.

We invite you to provide feedback and insights on Cormack Road, Park Terrace and Kings Road level crossings to inform the planning studies.
