# Freight Highway Upgrade Program

**Dukes Highway - Works Notice** 

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

### What's happening:

We are undertaking pavement works to improve road safety and rideability on the Dukes Highway between Bordertown and the Victorian border.

## How this affects you:

Investigation surveys are expected to commence from **Monday 26 February** for approximately one week at various locations along Dukes Highway. Please see map overleaf.

Pavement works on Dukes Highway, including along the overtaking lanes and road shoulders, will commence from Monday 4 March 2024.

To do these works safety, Dukes Highway will be reduced to a single lane with onsite traffic controllers in place to control the direction of traffic. Speed restrictions will also be required during work hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, Dukes Highway will be fully reopened with speed restrictions in place. Speed restrictions will remain in place until line marking is fully complete. Temporary speed limits apply to all road users in the work area, even when workers are not on site.

During the works, there may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.
