Works notice

We are improving safety for all road users at Naracoorte Road

The project is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments as part of the Heavy Vehicle Safety and Productivity Program.

What's happening

Major works are recommencing on Naracoorte Road between Meatworks Road, Bordertown and Stott Road, Western Flat from Monday, 28 October 2024, weather permitting.

Remaining works will include shoulder sealing, safety barrier installation and line marking.

How this affects you

To undertake these works safely, we'll have speed and lane restrictions in place throughout the work area. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and observe on site signage.

Outside of work hours speed restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions. We will ensure every effort is made to minimise speed restrictions outside of working hours as much as possible.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.

You will still be able to access businesses and homes. If we need to temporarily limit access, we'll let property owners know ahead of time.
