

Clarence Park Railway Station

Active Pedestrian Crossing

We are improving safety and accessibility along the rail network and will be installing an Active Pedestrian Crossing at the southern end of Clarence Park Railway Station.

What's happening

We are continuing works on the Active Pedestrian Crossing and will be activating the crossing, as well as re-asphalting and installing button top tactiles along the platform during this next phase of works ahead of completion.

These works will take place continuously during a Seaford rail line closure. Works are scheduled during this closure because they can only be performed when the trains are not operating.

The works will occur within and around the rail corridor between Parker Terrace and Canterbury Terrace, Clarence Park.

What to expect

Completion of the pedestrian crossing will include testing of the alarms and signals.

Test trains will be running from 7pm Sunday until 4.30am Monday. **Please look both ways for trains.**

Some noise from rail equipment, vehicle movements, essential communication between workers and the East Avenue level crossing will be unavoidable where possible, we will undertake the noisiest works during the day and will make every effort to minimise disruption to residents during these works.

You may also feel some vibration from the machinery and general construction activity.

Temporary lighting towers will be used at night to ensure safe working conditions for the team. We will ensure the lights are directed towards the work area, however there may be some light which spills into areas around the site.

Traffic impacts

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe while works are underway. We urge everyone to follow traffic management directions. Pedestrians and cyclists are encouraged to take care when travelling through the area.

It may be necessary to temporarily restrict some property access on Parker Terrace and Canterbury Terrace. We will provide advance notice of any impacts.

Parker Terrace will remain temporarily closed from Kelvin Avenue to East Avenue. Canterbury Terrace between Addison Road and East Avenue will be closed for the duration of the works. Please refer to the map overleaf for further details.

On completion of the works the pedestrian crossing will be operating as an Active Pedestrian Crossing.

An Active Pedestrian Crossing means when a train is coming, the pedestrian gates will automatically close. Alarms and signals will let pedestrians know it is unsafe to cross. When the train or trains have passed and it is safe to cross again, the alarms and signals will stop, and the gates will re-open.
