Regency Road to Pym Street – Night Works

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of night works for utility service investigations along South Road, between Regency Road and Pym Street.

Night works will commence Monday, 20 August, for approximately four weeks and will be undertaken intermittently along this section of South Road. It is anticipated that works will only occur in one location for a short period of one or two nights at any given stage.

The works will involve pavement and geotechnical investigations to provide information for the detailed design of the Regency Road to Pym Street Project.

These works are being undertaken at night in order to minimise the impact to road users and to complete the work safely and efficiently.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. Property access will also be available at all times. A 25 km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby businesses and residents, however, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are undertaken.
