Regency Road to Pym Street Project Day and Night Works

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of upcoming survey and ground investigation works along South Road, between Tikilara Street and Pym Street.

Starting in early June, DPTI will be undertaking pavement and geotechnical investigations, which will provide information for the detailed design of the Regency Road to Pym Street Project (R2P).

It is anticipated that these works will occur intermittently for up to three weeks, with geotechnical investigations (i.e. drilling) occurring in each location for one or two days or nights at a time. The majority of works will be undertaken between 7am and 5pm, however some works will be undertaken between 7pm and 7am in order to minimise the impact to road users and to complete the work safely and effectively.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however roads will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. Access to businesses and properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Efforts will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby businesses and residents, however, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are undertaken.
