

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

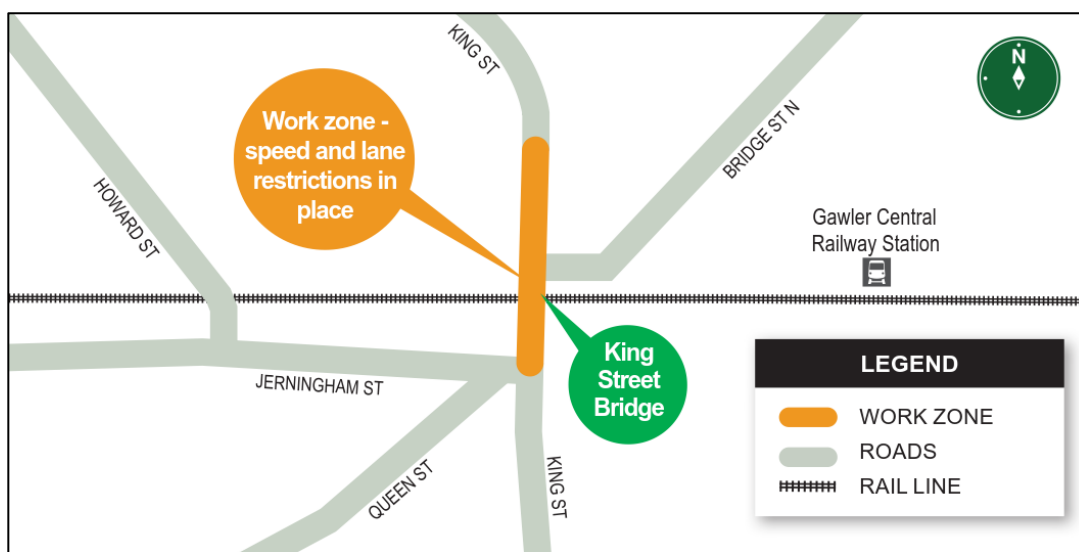
Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken on King Street, near the Gawler rail corridor.

Location: On King St, Gawler, both sides of the rail line, including the bridge (refer to map below).

When:

- From Wednesday, 6 November, for approximately 1 week, weather permitting.
- Standard work hours will be between 7am and 7pm. No works will occur on weekends.



What you can expect:

- A hydro-vacuum truck and handheld surveying equipment to pothole and identify underground services on King Street.
- Temporary markings on the road service to mark the locations of existing services.
- Project personnel operating on the road under managed traffic conditions.

Traffic management:

- Speed and lane restrictions will apply in the vicinity of works with signage and traffic management in place to advise motorists of the changed conditions.
- Access to residential and business properties will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained at all times.

Work crews will make every effort to minimise the disturbance to residents and businesses. Thank you for your patience as we undertake this important project.
