

# Payneham Road and O.G. Road Junction Upgrade

Dear Resident / Business Owner

**The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is upgrading the Payneham Road junction with O.G. Road, Felixstow. This State Government funded project will improve road safety, traffic efficiency and access for cyclists at this location.**

We are writing to provide a project update and to advise of changes to traffic conditions, during the Christmas period. To date, around half the project is complete, with works continuing during the first quarter of 2020.

Works will **not** be occurring on the project from **21 December, 2019, to 5 January, 2020**. During this time speed restrictions will be lifted. The dedicated left turn lane on Payneham Road will be closed to traffic. Instead, the two existing through lanes in front of the church will be configured as follows:

- The right lane will remain as a dedicated through lane for east-bound traffic.
- The left lane will be a shared lane from which motorists will be able to either turn left onto O.G. Road or travel straight through the junction.

While the signalised pedestrian crossing on the northern side of this junction remains inactive, the alternative unsignalised crossing located on O.G. Road, 50 metres north of this junction, will remain in place.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
