

Main South Road Duplication

Site Investigation Works

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is continuing concept design work for the Main South Road Duplication. The Australian and South Australian Governments are funding the duplication of Main South Road between Seaford and Sellicks Beach, which aims to improve road safety as well as improve traffic flow and increase capacity.

To further inform the concept design development, site investigations are required to better understand the existing conditions. The first stage of site investigations will take place between the intersection of Griffiths Drive/Robinson Road, Seaford, and Sellicks Beach Road, Sellicks Hill.

Geotechnical investigation works will be undertaken commencing **Monday, 2 November 2020, to Saturday, 28 November 2020**, weather permitting. These works will be undertaken at night, when traffic volumes are lower, **between the hours of 7pm and 7am**, starting Monday evening and finishing Saturday morning each week.

Further investigations will occur intermittently through the remainder of this year from Monday to Saturday, during the daytime where possible, however some night works may be required.

These investigations include:

- Location of underground services.
- Geotechnical and environmental investigations.
- Flora and Fauna assessments along the road corridor.
- Aboriginal and cultural heritage assessment.

All roads will remain open, with some localised speed and lane restrictions in place. Road users are advised to take extra care when workers are on site, and observe speed and lane restrictions and signage when travelling through the area. Pedestrians may also be temporarily detoured for short distances, with signage in place.

In the event that access to your property is required for these works, we will contact you directly to obtain your permission and discuss the nature of the works.

Some noise can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses, as much as practically possible.
