Station Refresh Program Works

Tambelin Railway Station

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering improvement works at 14 stations along the Gawler rail line. The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$20 million as part of the Gawler Rail Line Station Refresh Program.

Platform shelter works at Tambelin Railway Station are required to be undertaken continuously from 5pm Friday, 4 November to 6pm Saturday, 5 November 2022, weather permitting.

The platform will be available for passengers using train services during operating hours.

Some carparking will be used to store equipment and an exclusion zone is required for the crane lift to ensure work can be undertaken safely. Passenger car parking will be limited during this period.

Pedestrian access will not be affected during these works and there will be no changes to train services.

Traffic management will be in place around the work site to ensure the safety of our workers and the community. We ask that you follow directions and signage of the traffic management team.

During night works, temporary lighting towers will be installed along the platform to ensure safe working conditions for the team.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
