Tea Tree Plaza Park 'n' Ride

Early works notification

The South Australian Government has committed \$43.5 million to deliver additional parking expanding the Tea Tree Plaza Park 'n' Ride.

Development of the new facility's superstructure is underway. To progress these works it will be necessary for some longer work days to undertake early morning concrete pours and associated works.

Temporary change to work hours

From Thursday, 25 May to mid-July 2023, on approximately 10 days works will commence from 4:30am and finish by 7pm. The first of these pour days are scheduled to occur (weather permitting) on:

- Thursday 25 May,
- Friday, 26 May; and
- Saturday, 27 May 2023.

Please note that weather plays a key role in determining if a concrete pour can proceed on a scheduled date. If the forecasted or actual inclement weather conditions on notified concrete pour days are not favourable, works may be postponed or rescheduled to occur up to 24 hours either side of the dates notified without further notice. No works will occur on Sundays.

Notification for remaining early morning starts

The project team will provide notice of the next scheduled dates requiring longer work days. This will occur until all remaining concrete pours are complete.

Why these earlier starts are required

Earlier start times for concrete pour days will:

- allow suitable time during daylight hours to complete the entire 'place, finish, and cure' process required for each concrete pour;
- avoid late night and increased weekend works to accommodate the required pours;
- allow more daylight hours for each pour to dry between work days; and
- ensure project trucks are off the road for the afternoon peak.

You may notice

- Noise from truck movements and pumping and pouring of concrete; and
- temporary lighting to illuminate the area for the safety of workers and the community.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community, as much as practically possible.
