Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

Audio Tactile Line Marking

We are upgrading the Sturt Highway, between Gawler and Renmark, to improve safety and traffic efficiency for all road users. The upgrades are jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

We will be installing audio tactile line marking (ATLM) along the Sturt Highway between Truro and Annadale. ATLM is used to reduce "run-off-road" or cross carriageway crashes by creating a noise (audio) and vibratory (tactile) warning to road users who have strayed from the road lane.

How this affects you:

To undertake this work safely, there will be speed restrictions in place during working hours as the works progressively move along the Sturt Highway between Stonefield Road and Liebigs Road.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow the speed limits.

The Sturt Highway will remain open to traffic at all times.
