

# Freight Highway Upgrade Program

## Augusta Highway, Port Augusta – works notice

**We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes**

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

### What's happening

We are undertaking resurfacing works on the Augusta Highway between Edinburgh Terrace and Zerna Road, Port Augusta. Works will include stormwater drainage improvements, asphaltting, new kerb and gutters and new line marking.

The improvement works will enhance the existing road surface and increase safety for all users.

### How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions. During work hours speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the work area.

Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will remain in place as needed until all works are complete in early August 2025.

Please follow onsite traffic signage and the directions of traffic controllers.

Some noise can be expected while these works are being completed, however we will minimise noise impacts as much as practically possible. You may also notice some odour which is common during asphaltting works.

Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and public transport.
