

CITY TRAM EXTENSION *CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS*

Frome Road Intersection works (Friday 6 to Monday 9 October, 2017)



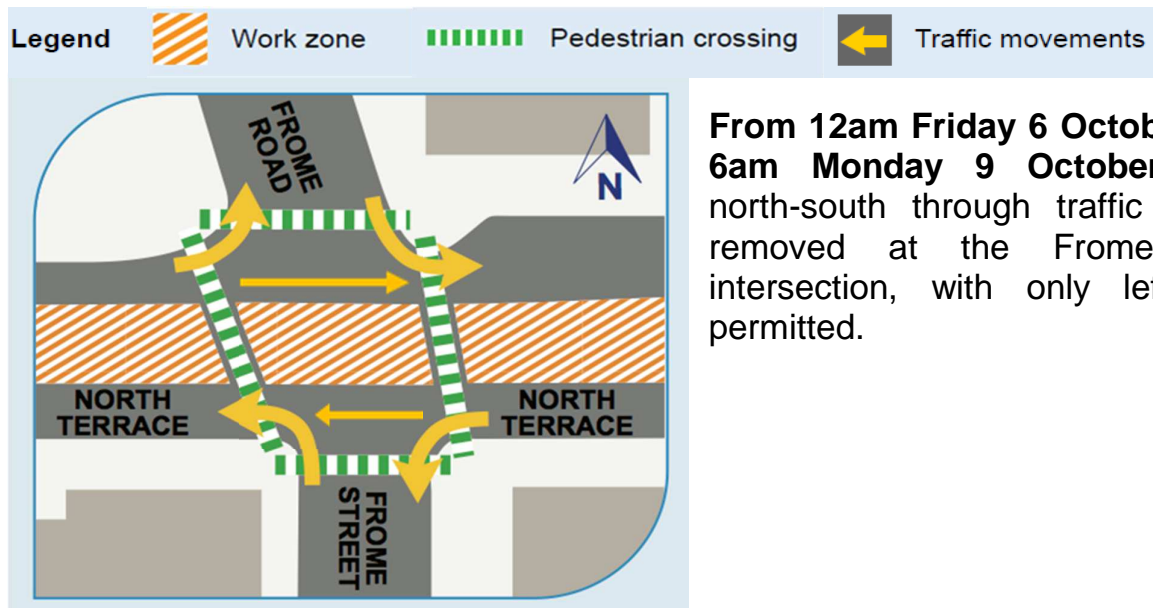
The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is currently undertaking works to extend the tram line from King William Street along North Terrace to the City's East End and along King William Road to the Festival Plaza Precinct.

As part of the City Tram Extension Project, changed traffic arrangements will apply for the duration of Stage 2 along North Terrace between East Terrace and King William Road from the evening of Sunday 1 October to 16 October 2017, weather permitting.

During these works, traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction along North Terrace, between King William Street and East Terrace. Right turns into businesses, side roads and at all intersections along North Terrace will not be permitted. This includes the Kintore Avenue/Gawler Place, Pulteney Street and Frome Road intersections. For further details please visit <https://infrastructure.sa.gov.au/ConstructionUpdate>

Frome Road Intersection weekend works

For the majority of Stage 2, traffic at the Frome Road intersection will be able to travel north-south with all left turn movements permitted. The exception to this is from **12am Friday 6 October to 6am Monday 9 October**, when only left turns will be permitted and north-south travel unavailable, to enable construction of this section of the tram line.



Motorists are encouraged to adjust their travel patterns by using public transport, finding alternative routes, accessing the Inner City Ring Route or considering other modes of transport during this intensive construction works period. Please plan ahead and allow additional travel time, particularly during peak hours (7:30-9:00am and 4:30-6:00pm). Signage will be in place to advise motorists of the changed traffic conditions. Road users are requested to take extra care when workers are on site and observe traffic signage and speed when travelling along North Terrace.

The *Addinsight* virtual VMS system automatically activates Bluetooth Beacons on the approach to a potential incident or traffic congested area and transmits real-time delay information.

Motorists with the [Addinsight App](#) installed and running on their Android or Apple device will receive an audio alert detailing the location and type of incident plus the expected additional delay times.
