Northern Connector Project

Port Wakefield Road and Northern Expressway night works and detours

As part of the Northern Connector Project, night works will be undertaken on Port Wakefield Road and the Northern Expressway off-ramp (southbound), Waterloo Corner.

Commencing: Sunday, 14 April, weather permitting.

Work Hours: Between 7pm, Sunday, 14 April, and 6am, Monday, 15 April.

Location: The Northern Expressway, southbound between Heaslip and Port Wakefield Roads will be closed. Port Wakefield Road, southbound between the Northern Expressway on and off ramps will also be closed, refer to map.

Activities: Preparation works for the Port Wakefield Road traffic switch, including line marking and installation of concrete safety barriers.

Traffic management: Access to southbound Port Wakefield Road will be maintained via a detour onto the Northern Expressway and Heaslip Road, refer to map.

Speed and lane restrictions will apply in the vicinity of the works. Signage and traffic management will be in place to advise motorists of changed conditions and to direct motorists through the detour.
