

Darlington Upgrade Project

Ayliffes Road, St Marys, night and weekend works 28 June – 1 July

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, road reconstruction works will be undertaken on Ayliffes Road, St Marys, from 8pm, Friday, 28 June, until 6am, Monday, 1 July.

The works will be undertaken on the eastbound carriageway of Ayliffes Road, between South Road and Norman Street.

Traffic Restrictions:

- Traffic on Ayliffes Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction between South Road and Norman Street.
- Both of these lanes of traffic will run on the westbound carriageway of Ayliffes Road.
- No right turn from Norman Street to Ayliffes Road during the works.
- No right turn from Ayliffes Road to Norman Street during the works. Motorists can detour via Stanlake Avenue.

A profiler, bobcat, water cart, street sweeper, grader, saw-cutter, excavator, asphalt truck and lighting towers will be used. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as possible.

Preparatory works will be undertaken from 10am - 8pm on Friday, 28 June, and will result in the eastbound carriageway of Ayliffes Road being reduced to one lane during this time.

The above works are weather dependant so may need to be rescheduled in the case of excessive rain.
