

Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project

Early Works Notification

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that SA Power Networks (SAPN) and SA Water will be undertaking utilities service relocation works in the vicinity of Mackay Street, Mill Street and Tassie Street. A new railyard access road will also be built off of Tassie Street, to relocate existing access away from the proposed new Joy Baluch AM Bridge structure.

Timing of works:

SAPN relocation works are currently underway and expected to be completed by late January 2020, weather permitting.

SA Water relocation works are programmed to commence in mid-February 2020, and expected to be completed by late February 2020, weather permitting.

The Genesee & Wyoming Australia access road is programmed to commence in February 2020, and take approximately one month to complete, weather permitting.


All works will be undertaken between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday, however some weekend work may be required.

Activities:

- Decommissioning and relocation of SAPN and SA Water services to facilitate construction works for the Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project.
- Construction of new access road from Tassie Street into the railway yard to facilitate construction works for the Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project.

What to expect:

Some minor services outages may be required to facilitate these works. Please note that SAPN (13 12 61) or SA Water (1300 729 283) will notify affected residents directly regarding service outages due to the works.



Temporary minor traffic restrictions may apply in the vicinity of the works at times. Signage will be in place to alert road users to any change to traffic conditions. Motorists are advised to take care when driving through the area.

Access to residential and business properties will be maintained at all times.
