

Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

Early Works Notification

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) will be upgrading the intersection of Goodwood, Springbank and Daws roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$60 million project is jointly funded by the South Australian and Australian Governments.

As part of the project, DPTI advises that service relocation works will be undertaken along Goodwood Road, Springbank Road and Daws Road to facilitate the new intersection realignment. These works will be undertaken in a staged approach.

Timing of works:

Service relocation works are expected to commence from early June 2020, weather permitting, with completion expected by the end of 2020, weather permitting. The majority of works will be undertaken each day, Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm, with the potential for some weekend works.

Intermittent night works may be required, between 7pm and 7am, in order to minimise traffic impacts and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently. Advance notice will be provided as works progress.

Major construction on the intersection upgrade is expected to commence later this year, with project completion expected by the end of 2021, weather permitting.

Upcoming Activities:

Service relocation works will include, relocation of SA Power Networks 66kV & 11kV infrastructure, SA Water main alterations, APA Gas works, relocation of telecommunications infrastructure and the installation of lighting infrastructure.

Some vegetation along the project corridor will be required to be removed to facilitate these works. Prior to any removals taking place, the work area will be inspected on site by a suitably qualified flora and fauna specialist and where required, fauna will be relocated to a similar habitat. Impacts will be minimised, as much as practically possible.

What to expect:

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access for properties will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Please note that during these works some bus stops along Goodwood Road may require temporary relocation, however public transport services will remain operational. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au when required.
