Aldinga Payinthi College Roads Upgrade

Changed traffic conditions and upcoming works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering local road improvements to support the construction of the new Aldinga Payinthi College at Aldinga. This upgrade is funded by the South Australian Government and will improve the safety and efficiency for all road users near the College.

Excavation works at the intersection of How, Bowering Hill and Quinliven roads, construction of new kerbing and footpaths, and the relocation of the koala crossing will commence **Wednesday, 25 August 2021, and be completed October 2021**, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday between 7am and 6pm.

To safely undertake these works, **southbound traffic along Bowering Hill Road and How Road will be restricted to local traffic only.** Please see the map over the page showing the temporary detours that will be in place. Northbound traffic remains unaffected. A 25 km/h speed restriction will be in place, while workers are on site. Outside of this time, a 40 km/h speed restriction will be in place.

Road users are asked to plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to Cardijn College will be maintained at all times during school hours. The school car park and kiss 'n' drop zone will also remain open throughout the works.

Access to properties in the vicinity of the works will be maintained wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the work site. Pedestrians are asked to follow directional signage, with traffic controllers onsite to assist. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

There is no change to public transport services during these works.

Project completion is expected in time for the 2022 school year, weather permitting. The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
