

East Parklands Road Upgrades

Road closures and parking restrictions

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport will be undertaking preparation works and road closures in the East Parklands area in preparation for the Adelaide 500 race event on **23-26 November 2023**.

What's happening:

Roads will be progressively temporarily closed from **Thursday, 9 November until Thursday, 30 November 2023**. Early works, including the installation of advanced notification signage and parking restrictions, will commence from **mid-October 2023**.

How this affects you:

The following road closures will be in place:

From 9am, Thursday, 9 November 2023

- Harvey Street, at the junction of Wakefield Road

From 9am, Thursday, 16 November 2023

- Fullarton Road, left northbound lane between Alexandrina Avenue and Kensington Road

From 6am, Friday, 17 November 2023

- Adelaide Parklands Circuit, Victoria Park/Pakapakanthi
- Dequetteville Terrace and Wakefield Road, including the small Britannia Roundabout
- Wakefield Road, from Dequetteville Terrace to East Terrace
- East Terrace, between Wakefield Street and Flinders Street
- Flinders Street, between East Terrace and Hutt Street
- Hutt Street, between Flinders Street and Bartels Road
- Bartels Road, between Hutt Street and East Terrace

Roads will be progressively re-opened from Tuesday 28 November, with all restrictions scheduled to be lifted by 6am on Thursday 30 November.

What to expect

- A series of road closures, temporary traffic detours, and speed and lane restrictions will be in place during works. Remember to follow signage, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
- Advance notice of local detours will be provided via the project website www.dit.sa.gov.au/EPRU and site signage will be in place to notify road users.
- Motorists should expect delays while preparation work is in progress. Please plan ahead, allow additional travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.
- A 40km/h speed restrictions will apply outside of working hours.
- A contra-flow will be in place along Fullarton Road, with two southbound lanes and one northbound lane open at all times. Some short-term road closures will occur between 16-18 November 2023 to accommodate after-race concerts.

Parking

Localised road closures, traffic and parking restrictions will be in place while these works are being undertaken. Parking along Fullarton Road, adjacent the Victoria Park/Pakapakanthi grandstand will be maintained at all times.

Public transport

Some Adelaide Metro bus services and bus stops may be temporarily impacted while work is underway. Please observe bus stop signage and visit www.adelaidemetro.com.au for the latest information.

Pedestrians and cyclists

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
