

# Pedler Creek Bridge

## Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is undertaking the installation of monitoring sensors. These sensors will be placed in strategic locations, allowing the Department to monitor the ongoing condition of Pedler Creek Bridge, whilst a new bridge is built as part of the Fleurieu Connections project.

In order to minimise the impact to road users, and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, these works will be undertaken each night from **Monday, 10 January to Thursday, 20 January 2022, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 8pm and 6am.**

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while the works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
