

Wellington Road and Heysen Boulevard Roundabout

Early Works Notification

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) will be delivering a new single-lane roundabout where the extension of Heysen Boulevard will meet with Wellington Road, to help support urban growth in Mount Barker.

This project is jointly funded by the South Australian Government under the Road Safety and Partner Funded Program and by residential and commercial developers.

Early works, including service relocation and earthworks are underway with completion expected late April 2022, weather permitting. The majority of works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm. Some night works may be required.

Construction of the roundabout is expected to commence in May 2022, with project completion expected in late 2022, weather permitting. Further information about the construction activities will be provided closer to the time.

To safely undertake these early works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place. Road users are asked to please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Whilst there will be some temporary impacts at various locations for pedestrians and cyclists, access will be maintained at all times, with traffic controllers onsite to assist.

Individual service providers including SA Power Networks, NBN and telecommunication providers will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.
