Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Pedestrian Crossing Temporary Closure, Brown Terrace, Salisbury

The Australian and South Australian governments are jointly funding the electrification and modernisation of the Gawler rail line which will deliver a faster, cleaner and more reliable service, delivering an electrified network through Adelaide from Gawler to Seaford.

As part of this project, the Brown Terrace pedestrian crossing between York Terrace and Brown Terrace, Salisbury, will be temporarily closed while test trains are running within the rail corridor, as part of the testing of the new signalling system.

Location: Brown Terrace pedestrian crossing, Salisbury (refer to map overleaf).

When: the pedestrian crossing will be temporarily closed from 6am Wednesday, 2 March 2022 to 6am Tuesday, 8 March 2022, weather permitting.

Pedestrian access and detours: pedestrian access will be maintained at all times via the southern pedestrian crossing at Chidda Railway Station and Park Terrace, Salisbury. Please observe signage and directions from traffic controllers.

What you can expect: You will notice test trains running on the Gawler rail line during this time. Look both ways for trains and be aware of your surroundings at all times. Only cross at level crossings and at recognised pedestrian crossings. Don't take shortcuts along or across the railway lines.


Further temporary closures of this pedestrian crossing may be required as part of future testing and commissioning works, however you will be notified of this in advance if required.
