## Woodlands Park Railway Station Construction Notice

Over the October long weekend, to coincide with the closure of the Seaford and Flinders rail lines, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) will be undertaking works on the platform at Woodlands Park Railway Station.

Works will occur continuously over the long weekend from 6am Saturday, 1 October to 4am Tuesday, 4 October 2022, weather permitting.

Temporary parking restrictions will be in place on Railway Terrace and Adelaide Terrace from **6pm Friday**, **30 September to 6am Tuesday**, **4 October 2022**. At times there will also be speed and lane restrictions on Adelaide and Railway terraces. Traffic management will be in place around the worksite to ensure safety of our workers and the community. We ask that you follow directions and signage of the traffic controllers.

For safety reasons the pedestrian crossing at the Adelaide end of the station will be closed during the works. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the subway which will remain open at all times. Please take care when travelling through the area. See map overleaf for more details.

During night works, temporary lighting towers will be installed along the platform to ensure safe working conditions for the team.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works during the day or early evening where possible.
