

Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Investigation works

We are delivering upgrades to key strategic arterial roads in the Adelaide Hills. The improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience.

The \$150 million Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening:

Investigation works are required to support planning works currently underway as part of this package. These investigation works include road and traffic volume surveys and taking measurements on the road surface to review pavement strength. Further investigations may also be required in early 2024.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Signage and traffic controllers may be in place to manage traffic flow and ensure motorists, cyclists and pedestrians can safely navigate around our work areas. **No works will be undertaken between Friday, 22 December 2023 and Sunday, 7 January 2024.**
