South Australian Regional Bridge Upgrade Aldgate Creek bridge and Leslie Creek culvert, Mylor

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading a series of bridges and culverts across regional South Australia to extend the life of the structures and improve safety for road users.

Major works commenced at the Aldgate Creek bridge and Leslie Creek culvert on Strathalbyn Road, Mylor in September 2022.

Works Update

To minimise impacts on the Mylor community, a change in construction methodology was required to enable works to continue without impacting power supply to residents and businesses.

As a result, the **completion of the main** construction work is now expected in June **2023 for both locations,** weather permitting.

Works completed so far include:

- demolition of the previous structures;
- new culvert in place at Leslie Creek; and
- 50% of the new bridge structure installed at Aldgate Creek.

Works remaining include:

- installation of the new safety barrier and bridge barriers at both sites;
- installation of the remaining new bridge structure at Aldgate Creek;
- new road resurfacing; and
- new footpath installations at both sites for the extent of the works.

Works will continue between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday and between 7am and 3pm on Saturdays. Temporary traffic signals and speed restrictions will remain in place on Strathalbyn Road for the duration of the projects.

Community Engagement

In December 2022, over 30 students from Mylor Primary School had the opportunity to watch the culvert being lifted into place at Leslie Creek. They also walked to Aldgate Creek bridge to view the construction works underway and ask the project team questions.

Project team representatives also delivered a presentation to the class, providing an overview of the construction works and safety.
