

# Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication

## Industry Participation



The Australian and South Australian Governments announced \$90 million joint funding for the construction of an overpass at the intersection of Augusta Highway and the Copper Coast Highway, along with duplication of Port Wakefield Road through the Port Wakefield.

The Australian Government committed \$72 million with an \$18 million commitment from the State Government of South Australia.

The Industry Participation Policy (IPP) addresses the Government's commitment to ensuring that competitive South Australian-based businesses are given full, fair and reasonable opportunity to be considered for contracts being undertaken by the public sector.

The Industry Participation Policy is intended to deliver greater economic contribution to the state from procurement and these benefits include:

- employment and workforce development
- improved industry capability and capacity through capital investment
- retention of economic activity in the State
- additional value-adding activities, innovation and supply chain development

To help achieve this goal, the Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication project will tailor an Industry Participation Policy Plan to identify and consider South Australian based small and medium sized enterprises involvement in the project.
