

# Strathalbyn Road

## Asphalt works and detours

We are upgrading Strathalbyn Road, between Strathalbyn and Stirling, to improve road safety for all users.

### What's happening:

These works, between Echunga Road and River Road, have been rescheduled to now start from 2 April 2024. During this time, it will be necessary to temporarily close sections of Strathalbyn Road to safely undertake final asphaltting.

**Road closures will only occur during the day. Strathalbyn Road will be re-opened at night.** Please observe detour and road safety signage and take care when travelling through the area.

#### Stage 1 - Echunga Road to Dolman Road, Echunga

Heavy vehicles over 15 metres in length will be required to stop temporarily on approach and then continue on Strathalbyn Road at a reduced speed and under direction of traffic management staff.

All other road users will be detoured via Echunga Road and Dolman Road.

#### Stage 2 - Shepherd Road, Echunga to Glen Bold Road, Biggs Flat

Heavy vehicles over 15 metres in length will be required to stop temporarily on approach and then continue on Strathalbyn Road at a reduced speed and under direction of traffic management staff.

All other road users will be detoured via Shepherd Road, Berry Road, Diggings Road and Glen Bold Road.

#### When

Tuesday 2 April to the end of April 2024, weather permitting

#### Hours of operation

Between 7am and 7pm each day

#### Where

Strathalbyn Road between Echunga Road, Echunga and River Road, Mylor

Stage 3 - Glen Bold Road, Biggs Flat to River Road, Mylor

Strathalbyn Road will remain open to all road users with speed and lane restrictions in place.

**Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times and in the event of a bushfire, other emergency, or on catastrophic fire days, Strathalbyn Road will be opened and posted speed limits will be reinstated, where possible.**

## How this affects you:

Local access will be maintained so if you live or work on Strathalbyn Road between Echunga Road and River Road and you will still be able to access your property or business.

There will be some noise from construction and vehicle movements, and you may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting is underway.

Every effort will be made to minimise disturbance and impacts to the local community.

Line marking and finishing works will occur in the weeks following the completion of asphaltting.
