Gawler Rail Electrification Project

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to advise that the first stage of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project is now underway. DPTI has announced local contractor Lendlease as the delivery partner for this project.

The project will deliver faster, safer and more reliable rail services. The electrified Gawler line will be a modern, environmentally friendly and efficient train service that will encourage more people to leave the car at home and take public transport.

What the project involves

The first stage of the electrification of the Gawler line will be between Adelaide and Salisbury, and will help create approximately 135 jobs a year during construction. The works include:

- installation of the 25kV overhead wiring system including masts and gantries;
- installation of a new signalling system;
- installation of a new fibre optic communications system cable;
- fencing works, vegetation trimming and removal and other works necessary to enable the electrification to proceed; and
- services relocations.

Project timing and scheduled changes to rail services

The construction schedule has been coordinated to balance the needs of commuters, road users, residents and businesses.

Early works have commenced, for example service relocations, with main construction works planned to commence in the 3rd quarter of 2018. The project is scheduled for completion in 2020.

To minimise disruption to businesses and residents during the project, the works program will be undertaken in a combination of day and night works. Advance notice will be provided of night works occurring.

Some short-term line closures will be scheduled during the quieter commuter periods, for example school holidays, when there is less of a demand on the line. Substitute buses will be in place to accommodate commuters during the short-term closures and Adelaide Metro will provide advance notification of any changes to rail services.

You may see project personnel within the rail corridor, at pedestrian crossings and at rail level crossings undertaking early works, with activities in each area taking between 2-4 weeks.

Businesses and residents in the vicinity of these early works will be notified in advance and access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
