# Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

# Euston Avenue temporary closure and night works

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, earthworks, drainage and pavement works are required to be undertaken at the junction of Euston Avenue and Fullarton Road, Highgate.

#### What to expect

Works will occur on the eastern end of Euston Avenue (adjacent to Fullarton Road) and will involve earthworks, trench excavation, installation of drainage pipes and pavement installation.

Works are scheduled to commence on Monday, 10 October 2022, and are expected to be completed the morning of Tuesday, 1 November 2022, weather permitting.

The majority of these works will be undertaken during the day between 7am and 7pm, Monday to Saturday. To safely undertake this work, some night works may be required. Night work hours are 7pm to 6am. No works will be undertaken on Friday or Saturday nights.

To safely facilitate these works, **Euston Avenue will be temporarily closed at Fullarton Road for the full duration of the work period.** Motorists will be required to detour via Avenue Road and Hampstead Avenue or Cross Road and Hampstead Avenue. Refer to the map overleaf for details. Please follow local detour signage and traffic controller instructions.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works during the day or early evening where possible. Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there will be some restricted pedestrian access and detours. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
