Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade

Construction Update

The South Australian Government has committed \$20 million towards the Mitcham Hills Corridor which includes the upgrade of the Russell Street / Main Road / Sheoak Road junctions.

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is planning to commence construction on the Russell Street/ Main Road/Sheoak Road junctions in the coming months.

Prior to construction commencing, service relocation works are continuing with the next stage of works planned to commence from Monday, 24 October 2022, with completion in December 2022, weather permitting. Works will include the relocation of SA Water and telecommunications infrastructure.

The majority of works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm, with some weekend works. In order to minimise traffic impacts and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, some night works may also be required. Advance notice for night works will be provided as works progress.

The planned treatments for the junctions can be viewed on the concept design on the project website (www.dit.sa.gov.au/mitchamhills). Thank you to all members of the community who provided feedback and insights throughout the design process.

Construction is scheduled to commence in late 2022, with completion expected in 2023. The Department acknowledges the importance of carefully managing works during the bushfire season. We will continue to engage with relevant authorities throughout construction and will maintain emergency access at all times.

Old Belair and James Road junction review

The Infrastructure SA (ISA) review of the proposed Old Belair and James Road junction upgrade is currently underway. We look forward to sharing updates on this review as they are received.
