

Spencer Highway safety upgrades

Work notice

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to Spencer Highway

The State Government has allocated \$10 million over four years (2024-2027) for targeted road safety initiatives on rural roads, including audio tactile line marking (ATLM), safety barriers and shoulder sealing.

What's happening

We are undertaking safety upgrades on the Spencer Highway between Wallaroo and Moonta. Works will include shoulder sealing and the installation of audio tactile line marking (ATLM).

These upgrades will increase road safety for all road users.

How this affects you

The Spencer Highway will remain open at all times.

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area during work hours. Outside of work hours speed restrictions will remain in place as required.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and observe onsite signage.

Access to properties will be maintained. Advance notice will be provided if temporary access restrictions are required.

Thank you for your patience and understanding while we complete these critical safety upgrades.
