

The Grove Way and Canterbury Drive Junction and The Grove Way and Green Valley Drive Junction, Salisbury Heights

Commencement of works

We are improving road safety and accessibility in the northern suburbs.

This program involves planning, designing and constructing upgrades to improve access to and from local roads and improve access for vehicles to travel north from Salisbury Heights.

What's happening

Works are commencing on the junctions of The Grove Way and Canterbury Drive and The Grove Way and Green Valley Drive in Salisbury Heights. These upgrades include:

- Widening the centre median to facilitate safer right turns from Canterbury Drive/Green Valley Drive into The Grove Way.
- Road widening and footpath realignment to accommodate the expanded median.
- Installation of a new pedestrian refuge and pram ramps for improved accessibility and safety.

Works will commence at the junction of The Grove Way and Canterbury Drive from Wednesday 27 August 2025. The junction of The Grove Way and Green Valley Drive will commence in the following weeks. Both locations are expected to be complete late 2025.

How this affects you

To safely undertake this work, temporary road closures will be required.

From Monday 8 September 2025, Nicholas Avenue will be closed at The Grove Way junction. This closure will be in place for approximately 8 weeks (weather permitting) with detours in place. Detour map will be provided in advance of the closure.

Wednesday 27 August 2025 to late 2025, weather permitting

Hours of work

Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am and 5pm

Some weekend and night works may be required, with advance notice.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area during work hours. Please observe signage, plan your trips and follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will remain in place as required for the duration of the works.

Property access will be maintained throughout works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

During works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access to ensure safety. Onsite signage will guide you to other routes if needed.
