



Portrush and Magill Roads Intersection Upgrade

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Portrush and Magill roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$98 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

The second stage of asphaltting work will be undertaken at the intersection and on all approaches to the intersection **commencing Thursday, 18 November 2021. This stage of work will be completed Friday, 26 November 2021, weather permitting.**

Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.

Some noise disturbance can be expected while these works are completed. However, every effort will be made to minimise disruption to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Temporary partial intersection closure

The western side of the **Portrush and Magill Road intersection will be temporarily closed for five nights from Sunday, 21 November 2021 to Friday, 26 November 2021** while this work is carried out. This closure will facilitate the placement of new asphalt on the intersection. The road will reopen at the completion of the shift each morning.

Northbound and southbound traffic will be maintained along Portrush Road. Eastbound and westbound traffic on Magill Road will be detoured around the intersection via Fullarton Road and The Parade. Please see map over page for traffic detour information.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place. Traffic controllers will assist traffic turning right from Portrush Road to Magill Road east, and traffic turning right from Magill Road east to Portrush Road.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, detour signs, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons the footpath and bike lane on the western side of Portrush Road will remain closed between Beulah Road and Dover Street. Signage is in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Every effort will be made to minimise impact to the community and access to properties will be maintained throughout these works.

Public transport services will be detoured with advance notice of temporary changes provided at bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au
