

# Majors Road Interchange

## Project Update

**The Australian and South Australian Governments are jointly funding (50:50) the \$120 million construction of new on/off ramps for the Southern Expressway at Majors Road.**

The Majors Road Interchange Project will provide commuters in the southern suburbs further access to the Southern Expressway, whilst also providing improved access to Glenthorne National Park - Ityamaitpinna Yarta, Sam Willoughby International BMX Facility and Southern Soccer Facility from the Southern Expressway.

Community engagement is an important part of the planning, design and delivery stages of the project. The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) recently sought input from the community to help inform the design of the new Majors Road Interchange.

Consultation commenced on Wednesday, 10 August 2022 and closed on Wednesday, 7 September 2022. Thank you to all members of the community who took the time to provide feedback.

During this period:

- the Department received over 745 online survey responses;
- information about the consultation was provided digitally to over 4,000 stakeholders via email and reached over 22,000 people through departmental social media channels;
- the Department held five community pop-up sessions to meet the community and seek feedback which were attended by over 250 people; and
- a total of 15 email submissions were also received.

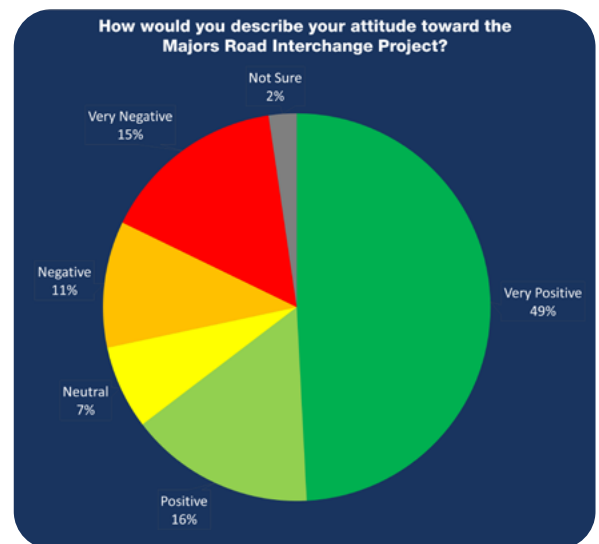
## What we heard during the recent consultation period

The Department asked community to indicate their attitude towards the new Majors Road Interchange.

Of the 745 survey responses, 472 (64.66%) responded they felt Positive about the project. 190 (26.03%) indicated a Negative response while a further 68 people indicated a Neutral response. A small number of respondents chose to not answer this question

Throughout the consultation, the Department received a significant number of specific comments relating to minimising impacts to Glenthorne National Park - Ityamaitpinna Yarta and the existing Mountain Bike Trails in the area.

**Following the initial consultation process, the Department has developed a proposed concept design for the new Majors Road Interchange.**

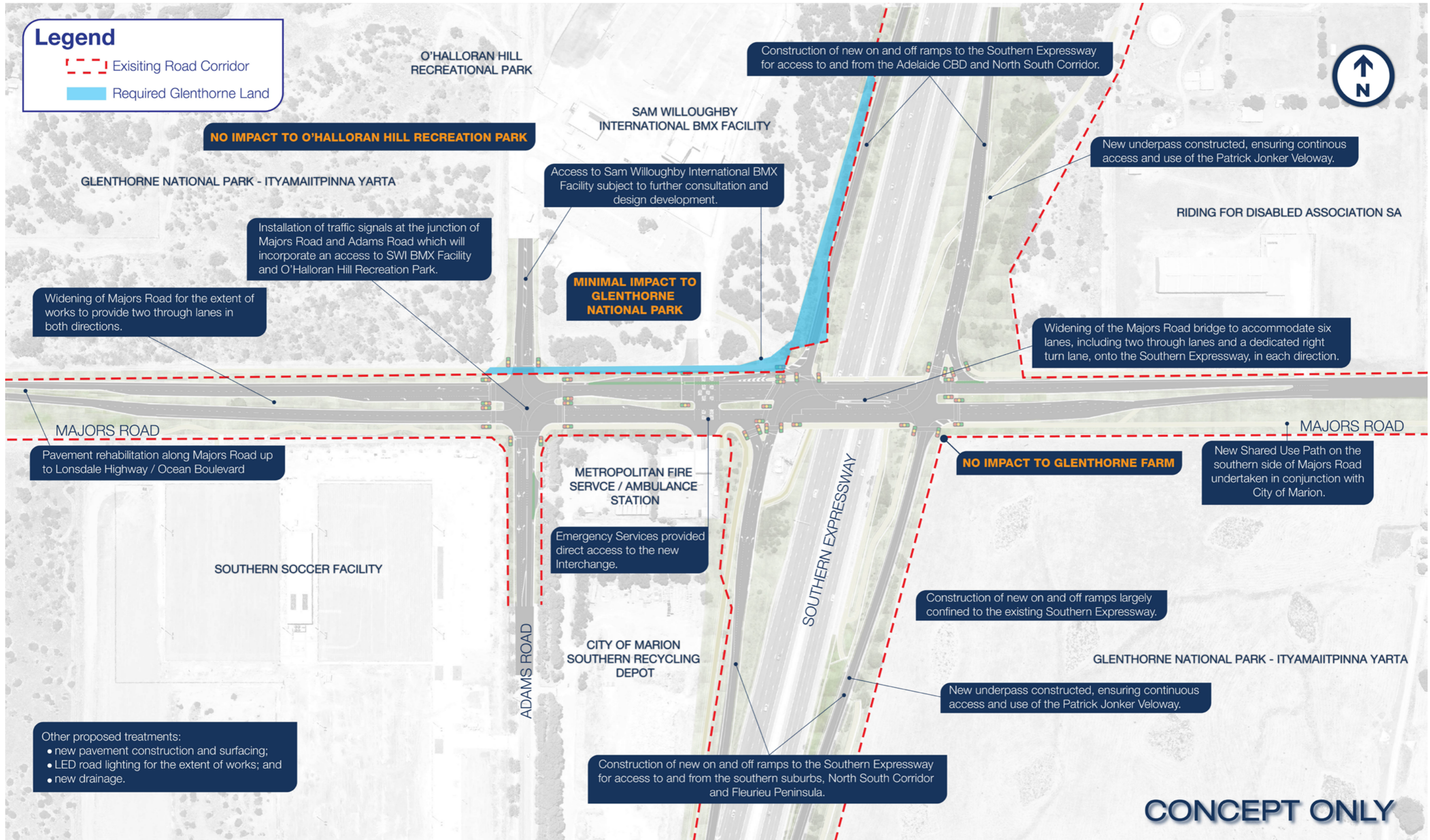

# MAJORS ROAD INTERCHANGE PROPOSED CONCEPT DESIGN





## Glenthorne National Park - Ityamaitpinna Yarta

The proposed concept design has been developed to include minimal impact to the Glenthorne National Park - Ityamaitpinna Yarta. It also provides for no impact to significant vegetation and no impact to Glenthorne Farm. There is also no impact to the O'Halloran Hill Recreation Park.

### Key design features

The concept design features include:

- new on and off ramps in both directions to the Southern Expressway, largely confined to the existing road corridor;
- widening of the Majors Road bridge to accommodate two through lanes and a dedicated right turn lane, onto the Southern Expressway, in each direction;
- signalised intersection to improve access to Majors Road from Adams Road with increased safety and efficiency;
- new dedicated bike lane on the northern side of Majors Road and new Shared Use Path on the southern side of Majors Road through the Interchange;
- new underpasses installed, ensuring continued access and use of the Patrick Jonker Veloway; and
- new and upgraded traffic signals, road lighting and drainage

### Next steps and feedback

The Department will continue to engage with key stakeholders, local council and the community as the project progresses. Community consultation on the proposed design will close on Friday, 2 December 2022. Early works will begin on the project in late 2022, with completion expected by the end of 2025.

### Procurement Commenced

The project procurement process has also commenced with an Expression of Interest to be released on 31 October 2022 via SA Tenders and Contracts, for suitably prequalified companies to undertake the Design and Construction of the Interchange.
