Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Investigation Works

The Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package aims to upgrade some of the region's key strategic arterial roads. The \$150 million initiative, jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian government's (80:20), includes a range of road improvements to support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience in the Adelaide Hills area.

What to expect

As part of the planning works for the junction of Junction Road and Jones Road, Balhannah, further investigation works are required to understand underground services.

Site investigations are expected to occur between **Monday**, **7 August 2023 and Friday**, **11 August 2023**, weather permitting.

These works will involve service locating equipment detecting any underground services and potholing works. The majority of these works will be **undertaken during the day between 9am and 3pm**.

Junction Road will remain open to traffic at all times however temporary lane and speed restrictions will be required when workers are on site. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe traffic management signs, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Refer to map overleaf.

Access to properties in the area will be maintained at all times during works. In the event that private property access is impacted, we will contact you directly ahead of these works occurring. Access through the area for emergency services will also be maintained at all times.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.
